The suv'eran rights of a Live Life Claimant, Native Earth Claim is separate from 'ownership' in the European sense, i.e. 'certificate of title'. As on land, kaitiaki responsibilities are independent of others who hold 'tenant usage rights' or 'whenua exclusive deeds'. Although as kaitiaki, the corporate governments may 'own' only a percentage of the land (air) space under their existing laws, the suv'eran still hold kaitiaki responsibilities over the whole area of the earth/soil/land/air-space in accordance with natural, unextinguished native title and universal lores/laws native earth claim of right. New Zealand Government does not hold a treaty or land patent with the originees, native, Mauri of the land, therefore they cannot issue certificates of title.

This Native Earth Claim is valid as it is endorsed by the Sovereign Crown of the Mauri Nation Chieftainess. No other valid claim exists. No corporation can have a valid claim as they are a corp-oration (dead entity). Only the absolute living man or woman can hold a valid claim.
